Construction Industry Activities/ Overview

- The Tung Chung New Town Extension project \$20.21 Billion), and CKR Main works project (\$42.363 Billion) received approval from the Finance Committee 1st and 2nd meetings respectively. Up until this date, the total sum of projects approved by the Finance Committee (2017-2018) is around \$70.67 Billion.
- A Briefing Meeting was held regarding the proposed Enhancement on Appointment and Administration of EACSB Consultants on 22nd of September. Representatives from DevB spoke to ACEHK Members about changes to Listing and Grouping, Bidding Restrictions, Tender Assessment Method, Technical/Fee/Fee Quality Assessment, Performance Monitoring & Management, and Disciplinary Mechanism.
- DevB issued a circular on 13 October 2017 announcing a temporary extension of the maximum service break period governing the carryover of the reimbursement cap from one RSS employment to the next (for the same rank). With immediate effect, the maximum service break period is extended from 12 to 24 calendar months. (The stated objective of this hange is to maintain the resilience of the RSS system.)

BELT & ROAD

- Our Chairman attended the one day Belt and Road Summit on 11 September 2017. Under the theme "From Vision to Action" it will highlight how Hong Kong helps companies unlock opportunities under the Belt and Road Initiative. An important part of the Summit was to highlight how Hong Kong helps companies to unlock opportunities under the Belt and Road Initiative. For details visit:

- Both of our Chairman and Hon. Secretary attended the Co-operation Meeting with International and Mainland Relations on 22 November 2017. The theme of the meeting focus on the collaboration between ACEHK and HKTDC, which could help Hong Kong companies grasp Belt and Road business opportunities.
