# **Employment Subsidy Scheme**

On **18 March**, government announced a new round of Employment Subsidy Scheme (ESS), which was subsequently enhanced on **7 April**. ACEHK Member Firms are NOT on the "restricted list" and so can benefit from the ESS:

- Covers the three months period from May to July 2022
- There is no salary limit for employees
- The number of employees is capped at 1,000, based on the ESS 2020 data, or employee MPF accounts in 2021 Q4
- Subsidy will be max \$8,000/mth or \$4,000/mth (part-time)

Applications open for two weeks, from **29 April to 12 May**, with first payments expected to be made in May.

# YMC Mentorship Programme 2022-2023





### About the Programme

The mentorship programme is a year-long programme aims to broaden young engineers' horizons by interacting with industry leaders and experienced engineers from different organizations. They will have an all-round development through our diverse programme including social events, workshops and 1-on-1 mentoring sessions. These events will take place on a monthly basis. We hope that, on top of the on-the-job training young engineers has been receiving, we will nurture the young engineers by connecting future leaders with current leaders of the industry, provide soft skills workshop and business-related trainings and provide a networking platform for these future leaders.

#### Mentees

Mentee registration opened from **30 March 2022** to **15 April 2022** and around 40 mentees were anticipated. In fact some 86 mentees registered, which is an excellent result! However, in order to keep the number of mentees in this first round to 40, and thereby allow the intended 2:1 ratio with 20 mentors, mentees will be shortlisted on the basis of allowing a maximum of six per company; to balance the proportion within each discipline; and varied working experiences. The shortlisted mentees will be notified soon and invited to join a face-to-face "Greet and Meet" after work in first week of June 2022.

### Mentors

Recruitment of 20 mentors for various disciplines opened from **26 April 2022** to **18 May 2022**. ACEHK RPs will be asked to volunteer or to propose colleagues in their Member Firms who would be willing to act as mentors. Full details were provided via email as to the expected role of the mentors and the time commitment expected. All Member Firms are urged to strongly support this initiative for the benefit of our young engineers.

### **ACEHK Involvement on External Committees**

Council Members sit on more than 20 committees to represent the views and the interests of ACEHK. Some committees are more active than others. The most recent updates since the last Newsletter are:

- ArchSD. Next meeting will be held in May 2022.
- BD Taskforce on Industry Adoption of Electronic Submission Hub (ESH). Two briefings organised by BD were held in March 2022. Stage 1 of ESH will be launched in May 2022 to accept first submission, while amendment and resubmission will be accepted in June 2022.
- BD Authorized Persons, Registered Structural Engineers and Registered Geotechnical Engineers Committee (APSEC). Meeting was held on 27 April.
- CIC Taskforce on Construction Manpower. Meetings were held on 4 March and 11 April.
- CIC Taskforce on Reasonable Consultancy Fee Evaluation System. A draft evaluation report has been

- CIC Taskforce on Construction Expenditure Forecast. Meeting was held on 17 February to present the latest forecast, which will be uploaded to the CIC website in June.
- **DevB** Land and Development Advisory Committee. An invitation to ACEHK for nomination to the Building Sub-committee from 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2024 was received.
- EMSD Working Groups on Development of Best Practices for Operation and Maintenance of E&M Assets.

  The last meeting was held on 17 February. An e-booklet will soon be launched on the EMSD website.

## Talent Retention – Is The Problem Too Big To Fix?

Consulting engineering has long been facing several problems that affect the industry as a whole – increasing staff turnover rate and lack of middle management in the industry, as they are often enticed to join client-side organisations in the public and private sector.

As young professionals in the industry looking to pursue long-term career in engineering, ACEHK's YMC, supported by research firm Policy 21, undertook market research to gauge the views of 160+ practitioners from consulting engineering firms on their views on the industry and how to retain talent.

YMC held a webinar in **February 2022** to share findings of their research project with senior management of Member Firms. There was a very engaging and productive discussion after the presentation.

YMC hope that their work enables Member Firms to better understand the needs of our young engineers; to fill-in the perceived gaps and shortcomings in the working environment; to make a positive impact on our industry; and to play a part in nurturing our young engineers, who are the industry's future!

# Enhancement of Bidding Mechanism for EACSB and AACSB Consultancies

On 28 March 2022, DevB issued a memo ref. DEVB(PS) 106/43 pursuant to TC(W) No. 2/2016 and TC(W) No. 5/2018 to enhance the bidding mechanism for EACSB and AACSB consultancies in terms of (i) enhanced fee diving control mechanism; and (ii) adoption of referenced staff rates for additional services.

On 29 March 2022, DevB issued a memo ref. DEVB(PS) 106/43 providing the referenced staff rates:


