# Message from the Chairman



It is my great honour and pleasure to be elected as the Chairman of the Association of Consulting Engineers of Hong Kong (ACEHK) for the 2023/2024 Session.

As our society progressively returned to normal in 2023, Hong Kong's construction industry has

entered a golden era, leveraging key government initiatives such as Northern Metropolis, Kau Yi Chau Artificial Island, and projects like "Three Major Railways and Three Major Roads" as well as "Two Railways and One Major Road" in the Northern Metropolis proposed under the Hong Kong Major Transport Infrastructure Development Blueprint. Nearly HK\$100 billion will be spent per year on infrastructure projects, which equates to HK\$1,000 billion over the coming 10 years. Although the forecasted yearly capital works expenditure is at an all-time high, our industry is also facing unprecedented challenges, particularly in human resource shortages. According to the Construction Industry Council's Manpower Forecast for Hong Kong Construction Industry towards 2027, we are expecting to face a considerable shortage of professionals in a range of 5,000 to 6,000 in 2024 and 6,000 to 6,500 in 2027. Leveraging technological advancements from the past few years of the COVID-19 pandemic to drive evolution in our industry through digital adoption, automation, and innovation—is essential. This approach will reduce manpower demands while simultaneously enhancing delivery efficiency and quality, which is a 'must' to make our industry more sustainable and resilient.

On the other hand, talent retention and acquisition from Mainland China and other countries will be another focus in the upcoming years to support the growth and development of the consulting industry. ACEHK is committed to attracting new talents by telling good stories of Hong Kong. Following our participation in a career fair in Mainland China in 2023 with some positive feedback from our member firms, ACEHK will continue to support the Development Bureau and collaborate with other professional institutions and industry stakeholders to conduct career fairs in other countries and cities in 2024.

ACEHK will continue to take centre stage and play key roles as a bridge between the Government and the consulting industry, particularly in collaborating and working hand-in-hand with all stakeholders to implement large-scale infrastructure projects and to build a better Hong Kong. We are also committed to nurturing young talents to ensure the healthy and sustainable development of the industry in the long run. To engage and support our members, ACEHK will arrange an array of events and activities for the 2023/2024 session, such as site visits, technical forums/seminars, government liaison meetings, mentorship programs, etc. We look forward to your continued support and participation.

I would like to take this opportunity to wish you all a joyful and healthy Year of the Dragon.
