ACEHK Participation in Selected External Committees and Events

- BD Authorized Persons, Registered Structural Engineers and Registered Geotechnical Engineers Committee (APSEC). Meeting was held on 12 August 2022.
- CIC BIM Committee. Meeting held in November. The CIC Beginner's Guide on Construction
 Digitalisation Digital Platform for Construction Work Management is being finalised with publication
 expected shortly; the CIC Beginner's Guide to Adoption of BIM in Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs) is
 under preparation with target publication date in Q1 2023; and the CIC Beginner's Guide on Construction
 Digitalisation Cybersecurity Awareness is under preparation with target publication date also in Q1
 2023. The Teaching and Learning Kit for BIM Viewer Training was launched on 20 October 2021, and to date over 9,400 individuals have obtained the BIM Viewer Certificate. Discussions were held in October
 regarding the terms, requirements, restrictions and new policy on current ARE post set up and E&M
 issues: Companies would employ ARE rather then RE due to the budget allocated and the low availability
 of REs. As some AREs are already chartered, DevB suggested hiring them as REs but working as AREs,
 with the working period of ARE post increased from 3 years to 5 years.
- CIC Task Group Meeting on Publicity and Promotion of the Image of Construction Industry. The launch ceremony was held in mid-November and attended by ACHK Council Members and YMC.
- CIC Task Force for Strategic Review for Uplifting Construction Capacity. The second task force meeting was held on 30 August 2022.
- DevB Consulting Engineering Committee. Several meetings were held towards the end of last year with DevB and the Secretary for Development to discuss key concerns of Member Firms, including minimum RSS on-cost rate; reference staff rates for additional services; adoption of non-engineering staff as Professional (P) staff for project co-ordination or executive support; review of RSS Establishment; score in marking scheme for adoption of JV or bub-consultants in Consultancies; promotion of job opportunities in Hong Kong; and limit of liability. ACEHK also expressed concern on the current resource challenges. The next meeting will be held on 3 February.
- DevB Steering Committee on Construction Innovation and Technology Fund. Meeting held on 6 September and a paper was circulated on early fund disbursement to provide cash relief for applicants.
- EMSD Working Group on Development of Best Practices for Operation and Maintenance of E&M Assets. ACEHK representative joined the 2nd Best Practice Advisory Panel Meeting on 24 August 2022. The first batch of Best Practices Case Sharing Videos were endorsed.

Donation to Families of Victims of the Tower Crane Collapse

On the morning of Wednesday 7 September 2022, an unloaded 65-tonne tower crane collapsed onto containers at a construction site on Anderson Road. Three workers were killed and six others were injured.

During the Council Meeting on 20 October 2022, Council Members approved a donation from ACEHK of \$30,000 to each of the families of two of the victims of the tower crane collapse. The family of the third victim declined to receive a donation.

Subsequently, the donation was made in November 2022 through the Association for the Rights of Industrial Accident Victims (工業傷亡權益會) and was gratefully received by the families of the victims.
