

Construction Safety

Construction Safety Week Conference



ACEHK Chairman Ir Stephen MAK was one of the invited panellists for the session "How can we make a change to improve Hong Kong construction safety?", part of the conference organised by DevB and CIC, held on 29 August.

Webinar on Work Safety of Temporary Works and Tower Cranes



In response to the fatal accident at Anderson Road involving tower cranes and temporary works, DevB, CIC and the Labour Dept organised this webinar on 16 September. ACEHK Council Member Ir Francis YAU was invited to share his experience on the design of tower cranes.

ACEHK Launch Student Enrichment Grant Schemes



We are pleased to announce that we have a draft agreement with the School of Engineering at The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology. We will donate HKD 48,000 per year for five years (HKD 240,000 in total), with up to HKD 8,000 awarded to six eligible students. The Grant shall be awarded to registered full-time regular students enrolled on the Undergraduate Programme in the School of Engineering to participate in engineering-related activities, including competitions; conference for service-learning; seminars; professional events; intellectual exchange study tours; voluntary service; and service-learning projects.



We are also pleased to announce a similar draft agreement with the **Faculty of Engineering at The University of Hong Kong**. We will also donate HKD 48,000 per year for five years (HKD 240,000 in total), with up to HKD 8,000 awarded to two students enrolled on the HKU - Wu Zhi Qiao (Bridge to China) Programme and to two students enrolled on the HKU - Common Purpose Leadership Programme; and up to HKD 16,000 awarded to one student enrolled on an Exchange Programme approved by the Faculty of Engineering.

For both schemes, local and non-local students are eligible. The most important basis for selecting the Grant recipients is the type of learning programme they enrol in, as well as its relevance and future contribution to engineering. The Grant recipients will be invited to join activities organised by ACEHK, including those by our Young Members Committee, as well as networking with ACEHK young engineers and ACEHK Council Members.

ACEHK Participation in External Committees and Events

- ArchSD Communication Meetings. A lunch meeting was held on 22 June and ACEHK voiced-out concerns
 on the fee-diving control mechanism. It was also suggested to pursue direct engagement of Building Services
 and Structural Engineers rather than as sub-consultants to the Architect.
- BD Taskforce on Industry Adoption of Electronic Submission Hub (ESH). BD is endeavouring to advance the rollout of Stage 2 ESH to Q1 2023. The exact date will be announced when the system development matures.
- BD Authorized Persons, Registered Structural Engineers and Registered Geotechnical Engineers
 Committee (APSEC). Meeting was held on 20 July. Summary of discussions to be emailed to Members soon.
- CIC BIM Committee. Meeting held on 22 June to discuss TC(W) No. 2/2021 issued in December 2021 to
 update the policy and requirements on adopting BIM technology. The CIC Beginner's Guide on Construction
 Digitalisation Adoption of Common Data Environment was emailed to Members by ACEHK on 16 September.
- CIC Focus Group of Consultancy Services on Forecasting the Demand and Supply of Site Supervisory
 Personnel, Technicians and Professionals in Hong Kong Construction Industry. This topic was discussed at
 the meeting in June. CIC had recently conducted a survey on this topic.
- CIC Master Class on Common Data Environment (Project Managers). ACEHK Council Members participated in the kick-off ceremony for the master class on 1 September.
- CIC Task Group Meeting on Publicity and Promotion of the Image of Construction Industry. Meeting was
 held on 19 July where it was suggested to invite a young lady engineer for a video interview to promote the
 image of Construction Industry to youngsters, particularly ladies, who are under-represented in the industry.
 Meeting on 2 September. Launch ceremony to be arranged in mid-November.
- CIC Taskforce on Construction Expenditure Forecast. Meeting was held on 20 July. The latest May 2022 forecast can be found here: https://www.cic.hk/cic_data/files/Fore2022/eng/pdf/Bar%20Chart_e.pdf
- CIC "See What I See" Luncheon. ACEHK Council Members joined the talk on 24 August by Ir WAI Chi Sing, Managing Director of URA, and the talk on 20 September by Kevin O'BRIEN, Chairman of BEC/CEO of Gammon
- **DevB Consulting Engineering Committee.** Meeting held on 29 July to discuss pre-bid arrangements. ACEHK also held an urgent meeting with DevB on 19 July to raise our objection to proposals that following fatal accidents, contractors AND consultants could be suspended for up to 12 months.
- DevB New Secretary for Development. ACEHK Council Members met with the new Secretary for Development, Ms Bernadette LINN JP, on 19 August, to discuss matters concerning the consulting industry.
- DevB Security of Payment Legislation (SOPL) Task Force. On 20 July, ACEHK confirmed its support of SOPL.
- DevB Steering Committee on Construction Innovation and Technology Fund. Meeting held on 20 July and reported that since the HKD 1B Fund was launched three years ago, HKD 627M had been allocated to 2,561 applicants (including HKD 59M to 568 consultants). A further HKD 1.25B has been injected into the Fund.
- HKGBC Infrastructure Project Rating System Committee. During the meeting on 19 July, Prof Ray POON
 from HKU presented that both SQL and IS systems were not suitable for a Rating System, and recommended
 DevB to develop HK's own infrastructure Rating System.
- HKTDC Belt and Road Summit 2022. ACEHK Council Members attended on 31 August and 1 September. On 2 September, ACEHK Council Members joined the Global Forum Roundtable to discuss opportunities for Hong Kong service sectors, including engineering consulting firms, to serve Asia Pacific countries.


