# Message from the Chair

The Hong Kong Construction Industry has been affected by the COVID pandemic over the past year. The Newsletter this month shows the decrease in construction expenditure in the past year and it is still a challenge to the Industry in reviving an upward trend in the coming years.

While we have an expectation on the recovery of the economy and more government or private projects being rolled-out, it is also worthwhile to explore more opportunities in Greater Bay Area, which has been promoted strongly by the Government (see article below). In the past few months, the Council has participated in various forums on the new registration measures for consulting firms and professionals when working in Qianhai, Hengqin and the Greater Bay Area. We are delighted to see that more ACEHHK members have joined the registration and so can avail to more business opportunities

### Qianhai + GBA

Under the 備案管理辦法, consultant firms on the two government lists, i.e. AACSB and EACSB can acquire corresponding qualifications in the Qianhai by way of registration so that they can provide services in Qianhai directly. In order to facilitate more Hong Kong consultants to participate, the Qianhai Management Authority and DevB have worked together to simplify the registration procedure:

To encourage Hong Kong consultants to participate in GBA projects, DevB have promulgated *Interim Guidelines* that, with effect from **22 April 2021**, permit:

# 1. One Registration – Three Systems (一辦三通) covering the the nine cities of the GBA including Qianhai (深圳前海) and Hengqin (珠海横琴). Firms who have registered in this system do not need to further make registration in the Qianhai and Hengqin systems.

2. No Attestation Requirement (無須公證要求) for firms applying for registration, who can now make a request to AACSB/EACSB to obtain certification letters. Submission of works experience (工程業積) is optional.

A webinar co-organised by Qianhai Management Authority and DevB, was held on **21 May 2021** with the aim of introducing these new registration measures. If there is further interest from member firms, ACEHK would be pleased to request DevB to organise additional meetings or webinars for members.

#### **Recent ACEHK Activities**


- Government Liaison was maintained regular dialogue with the Development Bureau (DevB) through
  the Consulting Engineering Committee (CEC) meeting and communication meeting with the
  Architectural Services Department (ArchSD) to exchange views on government practices and policies
  that may affect the delivery of consultancy services. The most recent meetings were held on 28 August
  2020, 28 January 2021 and 25 March 2021.
- Review on Minimum Entry Criteria for Consultants Lists of AACSB. DevB recently circulated a proposal
  for relaxing the entry criteria for Building Services works and Structural works under AACSB, which would
  encourage non-local firms to bid. ACEHK is of the opinion that there is sufficient local competition in the
  market already without bringing in more firms, which would be detrimental to the interests of ACEHK
  Member Firms. ACEHK therefore advised DevB of our objection to these proposals. We understand that
  other professional institution that have been approached by DevB have also objected.


## **ACEHK Supporting Other Organisations**

- Supporting the Hong Kong Green Building Council Green Building Award 2021, with nominations open from 15 March to 15 June 2021, finalists announced in August 2021 and the award presentation ceremony will be held in January 2022
- World Green Building Council Advancing Net Zero Ideas Competition (registration closed on 7 May 2021)
- HKIE Geotechnical Division webinar Engineering a New Future of Cavern Development in Hong Kong to be held on **25 May** at 7pm
- CEDD Annual Concrete Seminar 2021, which was a webinar held on 28 April 2021

#### **Construction Expenditure Forecast**

The third meeting of CIC's Focus Group on Projected Construction Expenditure was held on 21 August to discuss the September 2020 update and whether this will fully consider the impact of COVID-19 also the delayed approval of funding works by the Finance Committee of LegCo (approx. HKD 170 billion). The slide below is the September 2020 update, prepared by RLB for CIC (http://www.cic.hk/cic\_data/files/Fore2020/eng/pdf/Bar%20Chart\_e.pdf). This shows a large gap between the upper and lower band forecasts and the downward trend in construction spending is already obvious:





The three periods were forecast as follows:

- Historical [Past 10 years] based on actual figures
- Mid-term Forecast [Years 2020-21 to 2024-25] based on public sector (projects in progress and under planning) and private sector (research data on building completion from property consultants)
- Long-term Forecast [Years 2025-26 to 2029-30] based on public sector (projects in progress and under planning) and private sector (based on the trend of real GDP growth)

#### **ACEHK Involvement on External Committees**

Council Members sit on a number of committees to represent the views and the interests of ACEHK. Some committees are more active than others. The most recent updates since the last Newsletter are:

- BIM Committee (formerly the CIC Working Group on BIM). Stakeholders Engagement Forum for the
  Construction Digitalisation Roadmap was held on 9 March 2021 and attended by ACEHK. There was
  an Informal Discussion Session for the CIC Fee Evaluation Study on 16 March 2021 and ACEHK
  joined the discussion on the development and formation of BIM guide in the generation of MEP
  digital joins for statuary submissions.
- DevB Steering Committee on Construction Innovation and Technology Fund (CITF). The CITF
   Steering Committee meeting was held on 22 September 2020 and attended by ACEHK. It discussed
   government subsidy to support project consultants for the wider adoption of MiC for private sector
   building projects; to dispense with the sub-ceiling for BIM training and BIM adoption in order to
   allow more flexibility for the applicant to use the overall \$0.8M subsidy and uplifting of subsidy for
   the use of prefabricated rebar. A CITF focus group meeting on evaluating the effectiveness the CITF
   was held on 2 February 2021 and attended by ACEHK.
- EMSD Building Energy Code Performance Based Working Group and Lighting Working Group.
   Meeting held on 4 May 2021 in which ACEHK were advised that there would be a forthcoming update of the Energy Code coming soon.
- HKTDC One Belt One Road. On 25 February 2021 it was announced that the next Belt and Road Summit will be held in November 2021.
- FSD Ventilation Installation Liaison Group. The 65<sup>th</sup> Liaison Group Meeting was held on 11 March 2021 and attended by ACEHK.
- Security of Payment Legislation (SOPL) Task Force. On 25 March 2021 ACEHK expressed concern of having a document similar to SOP for consultants in the industry and suggested setting-up a separate working group to handle this issue.
- CIC Task Force on Reasonable Consultancy Fee Evaluation System. Comments returned from ACEHK Members on 22 May 2020. Meeting was held on 21 February 2021 regarding the inspection report provided the consultants. Government's fee was excluded in this fee evaluation system study. VC meetings on Informal Discussion Session were conducted and attended by ACEHK.
- Hong Kong Green Building Council (HKGBC) Infrastructure Project Rating System Committee. In
  the meeting held on 1st March 2021, DevB reported that the Project Rating System was still under
  them and they were thinking whether the DevB or CIC would invite consultants on the development
  of this system. Also, DevB presented Green Finance initiatives to the members.
- CIC Task Force on Quality Site Supervision Practice. Since last year, CIC has uses a registration system for technically competent persons in private sector to provide quality supervision.
